# International Youth Camp Site at Villingen-Schwenningen in the Black-Forest

Since 2010 the scouts-group of St. Georges is running a modern camp site, adapted to handicapped people up to 300 persons in total. The area of 10.000 m<sup>2</sup> is considered to be a meeting point for groups of young people from Germany and all over the world as well as for school classes that want to stay over night in tents or spend time outside within dayly evnts.



On 6 individual grounds of different sizes, small and large groups have got enough space to feel comfortable.

# What does the camp site offer?

Each part has its own fire-place. The surfaces to set up the tents are equipped with water-drainage systems and are separated by terraces. Firewood as well as pole wood can be provided. Further-



more a common playing area is at the groups disposal. The place offers outdoors water basins. On request, electrical appliances for kitchen tools may be at your disposal. Even portable bench sets can be hired, in limited number only.

As the rest rooms are separated for boys and girls, the camp offers a certain comfort. A separated toilet for those in wheel-chairs is available, in addition to the bathes and showers.

There is a huge varity of shops nearby, where one can buy



food and beverages or any other necessary material suitable for the camp's life. We do particularly stick to a strict ecological trash separation. Litter bags are therefore at your disposal.

## Leisure organization

The camp is close to the public forest. There you can easily enjoy lovely bike tours, you can play on all kinds of grounds or hike within

the region, as there are many well-prepared trails. In the heart of the natural Park of the southern Black-Forest, one can, following the crest and walking towards the north, reach Pforzheim or going southwards, passing the Feldberg (1.493 m) reach Switzerland, via Titisee and Schluchsee.



The location provides not only a close contact to nature but also a large number of leisure installations, easily reachable from the camp. In summer you can quickly reach by walking the outdoor or indoor pools (about 1,5 km), the Minigolf or the archery ground. It's also

possible to walk to the old historical town of Villingen (about 2 km) or to the railway station (about 3 km).

There are reasonable priced public transport to Lake Constance and the "Rheinfall" in Switzerland as well as to the historical downtown of Rottweil and Frei-



burg. By train the typical Black Forest Town of Triberg can be reached in between 30 minutes. There you can find a huge climbing park besides the main attraction: the highest Waterfalls in whole Germany.

### <u>Arrival</u>

There are enough parking spaces nearby for private cars and busses. For those intenting to come by train, it is very easy, using public buses directly to the camp site.



### Price and reservations

Over night stay: 3,50 € per person and day (minimum occupancy: 10 people) Daily events: 35,- € (up to 10 people); 2,- € per suppl. person

Additional expenses are charged depending on the use of trash cleaning-up (5,60 € per 70 l-bag) and for firewood (40,- € per m<sup>3</sup>). We also request a deposit of 75,- € refundable after leaving the camp site in a good state.
